Inflation has finally reached us and therefore an increase of 100% on club match fees will now mean £2 instead of £1 with winnings paid out down to fourth place.



Membership Fees 2008/2009

It was decided at the AGM that membership prices will remain the same for current members at £15 per year.

NEW MEMBERS will be eligible for a 50% reduction for their first year making it easier for them to "tryout" club fishing, this will hopefully encourage more members to join at the reduced rate of £7.50/1st year.

Junior Member fees will remain unchanged at £2.50 per year
